MATERIALS

- grass plants

KEY TERMS

- flower head
- stem
- joint
- leaf blade
- leaf sheath
- roots

STANDARDS

OBJECTIVES

- Students will learn how to identify and label parts of a grass plant.

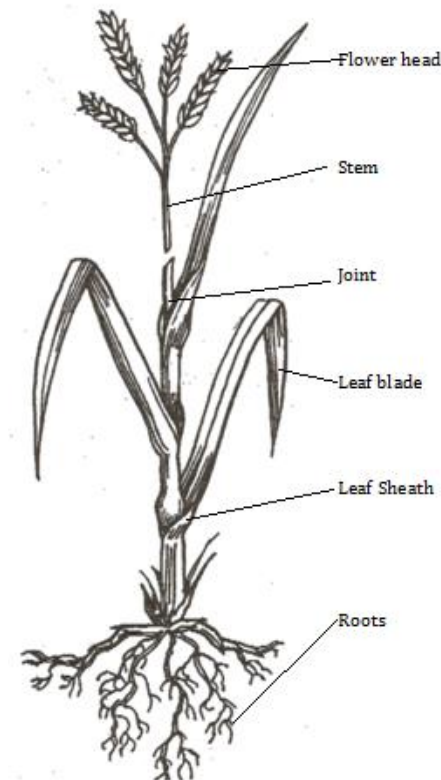
PROCEDURE

- Give each student a copy of the attached worksheet, “Label the Parts of a Grass Plant,” and have them identify the indicated parts of the grass plant.
- Give each student a grass plant, perhaps the plant they pressed during the activity “Identify a Grass Plant.” Have students glue or tape the plant in the space provided on the worksheet.
- Have students draw lines to connect the glued plant parts to the correct label.

RECOMMENDED ASSESSMENT

- Check students’ work for correctness.
