OBJECTIVES

- Locate animals using their specific descriptions.

PROCEDURE

- Have students use the worksheets to locate animals based on specific descriptions.
- Have students record which animal matches the description.

RECOMMENDED ASSESSMENT

- Check the worksheet for accuracy.
- Have students discuss different animals that share the same description.
- Possible answers:
 1. Sharks, skates, rays
 2. Jellyfish, some types of fish
 3. Many types of fish may have this many colors
 4. Jellyfish, some types of fish, sea urchin, starfish, anemones
 5. Eels
 6. Wobbegong shark
 7. Many types of fish, shark (Wobbegong)
 8. Jellyfish, anemones
 9. Sharks

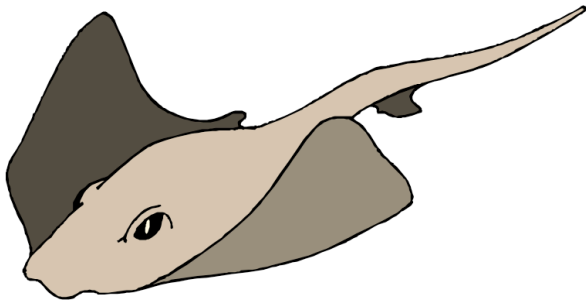
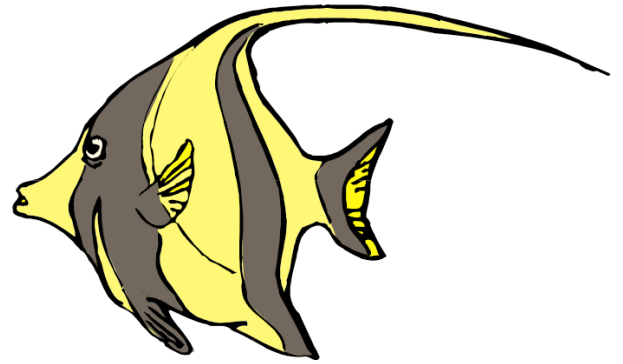
