• Students will learn that humans have caused animals to become extinct or endangered by destroying natural habitats, using pesticides, overhunting, using skins, feathers, or other animal parts for clothing or fashion accessories, and keeping exotic animals as pets.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- An endangered species is one that is in danger of becoming extinct.
- A threatened species is at risk of becoming endangered.
- If the current rate of habitat destruction is not drastically curbed, over 1,000 species of animals may become extinct each year.

OBJECTIVE


• Have students read each clue and unscramble the name of the endangered animal, using the letters in each circle.
