

CRAYON RUB

Using various media to portray animals



GRADES K - 1

MATERIALS

- cardstock
- envelope
- crayon
- scissors
- animal patterns

STANDARDS

- VA.K.8.2
- VA.1.8.2

OBJECTIVES

• Students will learn how to use different media to color an animal.

PROCEDURE

- Have students cut out the animal patterns.
- Have students trace the patterns onto cardstock.
- Have students cut out the cardstock patterns and put them into envelopes.
- Have students rub over the envelope with a crayon to develop the image.

RECOMMENDED ASSESSMENT

- Ensure the students are tracing the pattern correctly.
- Students should have one side of an envelope with an animal design imprinted on it.

EXTENSIONS

• Students can use different media on the cut out cardstock animal for added texture or color, such as felt, yarn, or textured paper.










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
