OBJECTIVES

- Students will be able to follow instructions to ensure they make the correct markings.
- Students will refine knowledge of shapes.
- Students will be able to use their knowledge of locomotion to identify animals.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

• Animals move in many different ways. Some of these modes of locomotion include swimming, climbing, crawling, hopping, walking, and flying.

PROCEDURE

- Have students put an X on the animal that hops.
- Have students draw a circle around the animal that swims.
- Have students color the animal that climbs trees brown.
- Have students draw a square around the animal that crawls on the ground.
