- SUPPORT my fellow campers, Counselors, and Teen Counselors by not bullying, teasing, or gossiping
- REFUSE to join in if another camper is being bullied, teased, or gossiped about and to notify a Camp Counselor about what is happening
- UNDERSTAND that cleaning-up is everybody's job
