

2024 School Field Trip Admission Worksheet

School Group Rates 2024 With Two-Week Pre-registration

Students and Chaperones: \$15.00/per person and one ride ticket with pre-registration.

Teacher: FREE with School ID.

Bus Drivers: FREE with School ID.

Members: (students, teachers, chaperones, and bus driver): FREE but do not receive a ride ticket. Memberships may be used to cover their admission with a printed copy of the membership card/code and members photo ID.

Coupons, including the Kids for Nature passport, and other promotional rates may not be used in combination with the School Group Rate.

To obtain the **School Group Rate**, you must fulfill all **three** of the following:

1. Be a PreK through college institution with a principal/director and school IDs. Daycares are not eligible.
2. Have 15 or more students registered in your group. (For special education accommodations, please contact our Event Specialist at 260-427-6800 x461)
3. Register online at least two weeks before your field trip date. Groups that do not preregister will pay General Admission price.

Any Mini Classes or boxed lunches must be registered at least two weeks in advance. Boxed lunches must be paid in full two weeks prior to your field trip.

School Group Rates are available year-round for those eligible. Boxed lunches and Mini Classes are only available during the school year.

Boxed Lunches:

Boxed lunches are \$7 per lunch.

Lunches must be ordered and paid in full at least two weeks in advance. Box lunches can be rescheduled but cannot be refunded.

Each lunch box comes with:

- (a) Choice of peanut butter & jelly, turkey & cheese, or ham & cheese sandwich.
- (b) Potato chips and a piece of fruit.
- (c) Choice of juice or water.

Payment Information

Field Trip payment is due before **or** on the day of your field trip. Invoicing/billing after the field trip will not be accepted. Registration must be done two weeks prior to your visit to receive the School Group Rate.

Groups that do not preregister will not receive the School Group Rate and will pay at the front gate.

Coupons and promotional rates may not be used in combination with the School Group Rate. Payment is non-refundable.

Field Trip FAQs

Where should we park our bus?

School busses must park in the Foellinger Theater lot, located just south of the Zoo. Students, Chaperones, and Teachers will walk their group to the front entrance and back to the school bus after your visit.

Can we leave the Zoo to eat a picnic lunch in the park?

Yes, simply tell the booth attendant your group's name for re-entry.

What all is included with a ride ticket?

Field trip guests who pay admission will receive one ride ticket to be used at the Z.O&O Railroad, Endangered Species Carousel, Sky Ride, or Crocodile Creek Adventure Ride.

How do I sign up for a Mini Class?
