Note: This does not include daycare centers, camps, or other organizations.

2. **Register online at least two weeks before your field trip date.** Groups that do not pre-register will be required to pay that day's general admission price.

3. A minimum of 15 non-member students.

Field Trip pricing is only available during your school's identified calendar year.

PAYMENT INFORMATION & FAQs

- Field trip payment is due on or before the day of your field trip.
- We can invoice your school upon request.
- A minimum of 15 non-member students is necessary to qualify for field trip rate.
- If your group does not pre-register at least 2 weeks in advance, or if you do not meet the criteria defined in the previous page, you will be ineligible to receive the discounted rate.
- Field trip dates may be rescheduled with a 3-day advance notice to groupsales@fwzoo.com.
- Buses must park in the Foellinger Theatre lot, located just South of the main entrance. For the safety of all our guests, school groups should not be dropped off near the front gate but should walk in from the Foellinger Theatre lot using the identified path & crosswalks.
- If you are leaving the Zoo grounds for lunch, please tell a booth attendant your group's name for easy reentry. If you purchase boxed lunches, these will be served in our Parkview Physicians Group Picnic Pavilions in the African Journey, near the Sky Safari Ride.
- Ride tickets or Ride Wristbands are good for the Z.O.&O. Railroad, Endangered Species Carousel, Sky Safari Ride or Crocodile Creek Adventure Ride (Log ride), or our Safari Summit Rock Wall in Africa.
